Waiver of Liability and Release for

Use of Pool During COVID-19

Pursuant to Executive Order D 2020 091, issued by Governor Polis, and Public Health Order 20-28 and the Guidance for Personal Recreation issued by the Colorado Department of Public Health & Environment, the Sable Cove Condominium Association (the "HOA") has determined to open its swimming pool. Every person, or a parent/legal guardian of a person under the age of 18 (the "Minor"), desiring to use or participate in activities on/in/around the swimming pools and related facilities, including restrooms (collectively, the "Pool") of the HOA must complete this Waiver of Liability and Release (the "Waiver and Release").

PLEASE READ THIS WAIVER AND RELEASE VERY CAREFULLY AND MAKE SURE YOU UNDERSTAND.

COVID-19 coronavirus ("COVID-19") is extremely contagious and is believed to spread mainly from person-to-person contact. Methods of transfer include, but are not limited to, physical contact, contact through breath, and contact with stable surfaces. Additional Information about COVID-19 and COVID-19 symptoms may be found at https://covid19.colorado.gov/about-covid-19. The HOA wants to make sure that you understand the potential risks of COVID-19 before you decide to use the Pool. There may be other risks and dangers, a complete listing of which is not possible and cannot be anticipated, and you assume all such risks and dangers, whether or not described here, known or unknown.

By signing this Waiver and Release, you recognize and acknowledge the contagious nature of COVID-19 and the threat that COVID-19 poses to the health of individuals, and you voluntarily and knowingly assume the risk that you or your Minor may be exposed to or infected with COVID-19 at the Pool, and that such exposure or infection may result in personal injury, illness, permanent disability, and/or death. You understand and acknowledge that the risk of becoming exposed to or infected with COVID-19 at the Pool may result from the actions, inactions and/or omissions of yourself and/or others.

By signing this Waiver and Release you certify that you have received any and all information that you deem necessary or important in making an informed choice regarding your own or your Minor's use of the Pool, and you voluntarily agree to assume all risks and accept sole responsibility for any injury to you or your Minor (including, but not limited to, personal injury, disability, death, illness, damage, loss, claim, liability, or expense, of any kind), that you or your Minor may experience or incur in connection with attendance at the Pool.

You agree to indemnify and hold the HOA, its officers, employees, agents, consultants, independent contractors, and representatives (collective, the "HOA Indemnitees") harmless from any claim, liability, damage, loss, injury (including death), cost or expense relating to COVID-19 which may result from your participation, or the participation of your Minor, in any activity in or around the Pool. You further agree to release, waive and discharge, and covenant not to sue the HOA Indemnitees for any and all claims, demands, losses, costs, expenses or causes of action whatsoever arising out of any claim, liability, damage, loss or injury (including death) relating to COVID-19 as a direct or indirect result of your participation, or your Minor's participation, in any activity at the Pool. This release of liability and indemnity applies to you, the undersigned, your Minor, as well as any of your personal representatives,

assigns, heirs and next of kin. By signing this Waiver and Release, you agree that you and your Minor will only use the Pool and participate in pool activities while in good health and free of COVID-19 symptoms, including, but not limited to, fever, cough, or shortness of breath.

2021 Pool Rules

- 1. DUE TO COVID REGULATIONS IMPOSED BY THE STATE OF COLORADO and a chlorine shortage the pool is open only when the cover is open. There will be no set days or hours in 2021.
- 2. The pool is reserved for the use of Sable Cove residents ONLY
- 3. Please keep the gates to the pool closed at all times. Do not let anyone in; all residents should have their own pool keycards. Failure to follow this rule WILL result in the deactivation of your keycard.
- 4. ONE Guest per pool card will be allowed in 2021.
- 5. To insure distancing requirements (6 ft), residents of 17 years of age or younger must be supervised at all times by an adult (18 years or older).
- No running, jumping, diving, fighting, or dangerous conduct is allowed in or around the pool area. Any excessive noise is forbidden in or around the pool area.
- 7. Residents are required to be properly attired at all times going to and from and in and around the pool area. No flashing of inappropriate body parts or Aurora Police Department will be contacted immediately.
- 8. Diapers, whether cloth or disposable, must be covered with rubber pants.
- 9. Persons having infectious diseases, open sores, bandages, cuts or recent vaccinations are not permitted within the pool area.
- 10. All refreshments must be served in unbreakable containers. GLASS OBJECTS ARE NOT PERMITTED IN THE POOL AREA AT ANY TIME.
- 11. NO ALCOHOL may be consumed in or around the pool area.
- 12. Pets are not allowed in the swimming pool area.
- 13. NO LIFEGUARD WILL BE ON DUTY.
- 14. Everyone must obey all directives from Sable Cove agents including Board Members, pool staff, and management. Failure to do so is not acceptable and may result in pool closure, pool card deactivation and/or fines.
- 15. Management assumes no responsibility for accident or injury and is not responsible for articles that are lost, damaged or stolen. POOL IS USED AT YOUR OWN RISK.
- 16. Residents and their guests must abide by all rules posted in or around the pool area and should observe any warning signs placed in or around the pool area.
- 17. No pool furniture will be provided in 2021.
- 18. Throwing rocks in pool area or into the pool will not be tolerated. Pool card will be deactivated for a minimum of 30 days and fines may be assessed
- 19. Every homeowner will use appropriate language around pool area. Foul language is not acceptable and may result in pool closure, pool card deactivation and/or fines.
- 20. NO barbecues are allowed inside the pool area.

Please keep the gates to the pool closed at all times. Do not let anyone in. Each resident must have his own keycard and must use it to enter the pool.
